Purpose:	<p>Australian Brick & Blocklaying Training Foundation Limited is coming to the school to deliver a 'hands on' chance to experience the bricklaying trade to the Year 9 & 10 VET Construction students.</p> <p>Currently there is a severe shortage of skilled and qualified bricklayers in the building industry, meaning there are career and income opportunities for young people interested in learning the trade.</p> <p>This 3 Day course provides a pathway to an Apprenticeship in Bricklaying and a rewarding career in the building industry. The course provides 'hands on' experience only and does not provide credit towards a future bricklaying, although the students will be using this course to contribute to the competencies of the Statement of Attainment in Construction.</p>
