Important Information for Returning UCHSK Students

The following measures will be in place from May 18th to ensure safety and wellbeing of all students and staff.

Health & Hygiene

- Students and staff must not attend on site at UCHSK if they are unwell. If a student presents with symptoms of illness, parents / carers will be contacted and asked to collect their child.
- All students and staff will be required to apply hand sanitiser prior to entering all classes. Hand sanitiser will be provided by the school and distributed for students by teaching or LSA staff.
- Signage will be posted, and explicit instruction will be provided on how to prevent the spread of germs, including:
 - Correct hand washing procedures. Students will be encouraged to do so at multiple points through the day.
 - How to cover coughs and sneezes.
 - Avoiding unnecessary physical contact.
- School bubblers have been turned off. All students are encouraged to bring a water bottle to school which can be refilled using refill stations on site.

School Equipment

- UCHSK will not be providing basic school supplies. Students will be expected to attend with a well-stocked pencil case, allowing for full participation in lessons.
- Students will be required to provide their own Chromebook and headphones for all online learning activities.
- UCHSK will continue to provide access to communal equipment used during practical lessons in classes such as:
 - Arts / Technology
 - Physical Education
 - Science practicals

School Site

- The school building will be open for students between the hours of 8:30am and 3:30pm. Any students arriving at school before 8:30am will be required to wait on the seating area at the rear of the building. We ask that students do not wait at the front of the school.
- The canteen will be operating at reduced capacity until further notice. The canteen will not be open at recess and lunches will only be available to students who order online. No over the counter service will be available. This situation will be reviewed on a weekly basis.
