

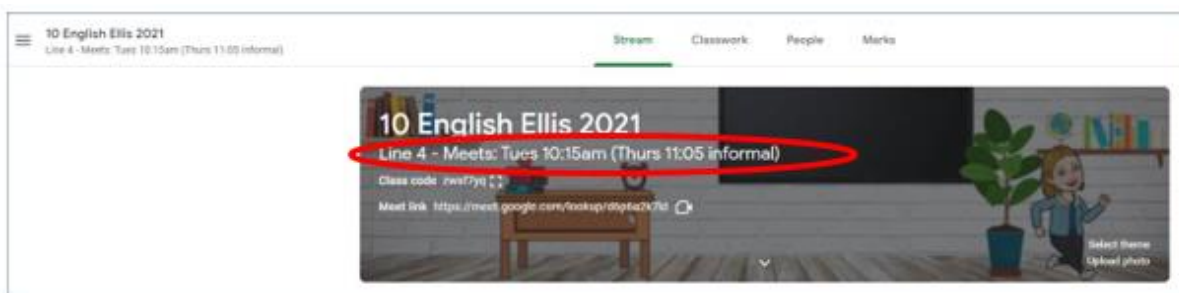

## AT HOME LEARNING – Frequently asked Questions

Thank you to those families who have asked questions using the [UCHSK 2021 At Home Learning - Parent / Carer Questions form](#). Some of the questions relate to quite personal circumstances. ### **My child is unsure when their Google Meets will take place. Can days and times of Google Meets for each class be communicated to students and families in a consistent manner?**

From Week 9, all Google Meet days and times will be written in the Google Classroom banner at the top of each Google Classroom page (example below). The [UCHSK Class Line Rotation](#) identifies times when different classes may run Google Meets. As the requirements of all classes differ, teachers will make the decision if the times allocated on the Line Rotation will be used for one or two Google Meets each week.



Families of students engaged in small group classes, through our Inclusive Education faculty, will receive a follow up email clarifying Google Meet times for these students.

### **What are the expectations for the completion of classwork? Will there be assessment and reporting consequences for uncompleted work?**

While the complexities of *At Home Learning* will be considered throughout the assessment and reporting process, assessment of student achievement and end of semester A-E reporting will go ahead. If there are extenuating circumstances which are impacting your child's ability to submit classwork, please contact the class teacher to discuss.

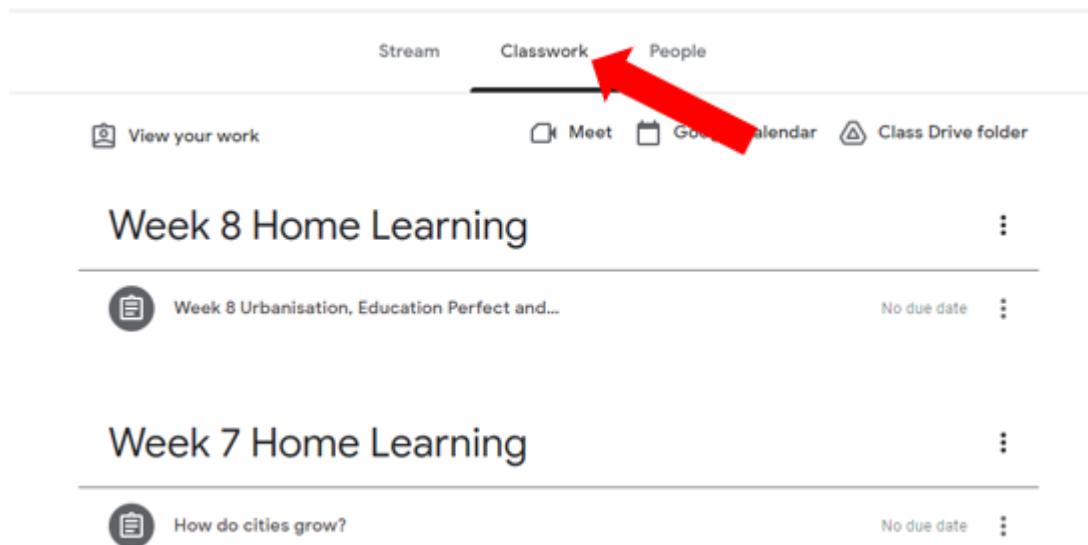
To ensure we provide multiple opportunities for feedback on student achievement, during the *At Home Learning* period and prior to end of semester reports, we have re-introduced regular "Engagement" letters for families. This letter will inform families of instances where children have had *Partial, Limited* or *No Engagement* with selected classes or with set tasks, during online lessons.

### **My child is unable to access the Google Classroom for certain classes.**

All students should have received an invitation to join each of their Google Classrooms. This is received as an email into their student Gmail account. If you are unable to locate the email invitation, please contact the appropriate teacher via email ([firstname.lastname@ed.act.edu.au](mailto:firstname.lastname@ed.act.edu.au)) and they will be able to provide your child a new invitation or access code to the Google Classroom.

### **My child is unsure of the lesson by lesson expectations for work completion.**

Each faculty has set out their learning program on a week by week basis. The learning activities for the designated weeks are outlined in the Google Classroom under the Classwork tab then under the relevant Week heading (image below). This is designed to support students and families who, due to individual circumstances, are unable to align their At Home Learning routine with the [UCHSK Daily Schedule](#) or [UCHSK Class Line Rotation](#). Should your child's personal circumstance require a level of additional support to access and / or understand the learning tasks, please make contact with class teacher via email ([firstname.lastname@ed.act.edu.au](mailto:firstname.lastname@ed.act.edu.au)).



### **Could PC time include more structured social interaction?**

Monday to Thursday 15min PC check ins may include Google Meets for social interaction at teacher discretion. Friday PC lessons (10:00-10:55) have social time built in to each lesson, with some discussion on the lesson material (eg Book Week costume explanations and conversations) and then ending with social interaction and check ins. Teachers have the autonomy to deliver this material in a way that suits the needs of their students. Therefore, there may be times when this is delivered differently depending on the specific PC class.
